

PICKET FRAME

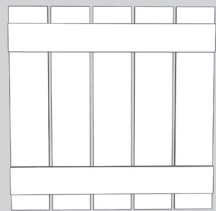


MATERIALS

- 2 1/4" x 1/4" x 12" Hemlock Lattice (5) (back verticals)
- 1 5/8" x 1/4" x 12" Hemlock Lattice (2) (front horizontals)
- 1/2" Wire nails (10)
- Small sawtooth hanger (1)
- 1" Mini clothespins (2)
- Wood glue
- Paint, Stain, or Spray Paint

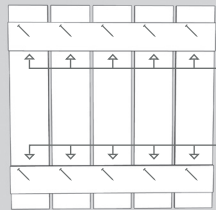
ASSEMBLY TOOLS

- Hammer
- Tape measure
- Pencil
- Paint brush or foam brush (unless spray paint is used)



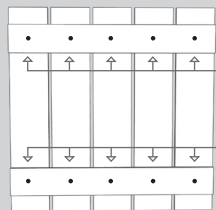
STEP ONE

Arrange the 5 vertical pieces of 2 1/4" x 1/4" x 12" lattice with the 2 horizontal pieces of 1 5/8" x 1/4" x 12" lattice on top.



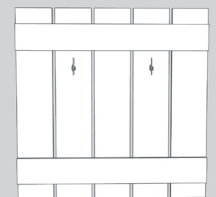
STEP THREE

Run a line of wood glue on the back of each horizontal piece before nailing. Be careful not to use too much glue.



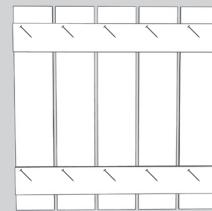
STEP FIVE

Nail the top and bottom horizontal pieces to the vertical pieces.



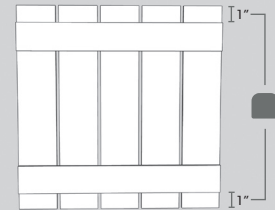
STEP SEVEN

Flip the frame over to the front and use a small amount of wood glue to attach the mini 1" clothespins. This frame can accommodate 4x6 and 5x7 photos so having a photo handy can help for visual reference.



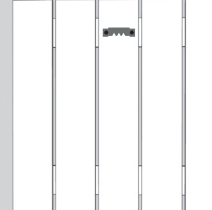
STEP TWO

Start 1/2" wire nails in the middle of the horizontal pieces at intersections with the vertical pieces.



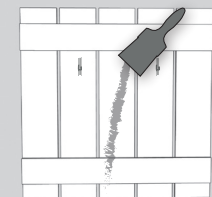
STEP FOUR

Use a tape measure to space the horizontal pieces 1" from the top and bottom edge of the frame.



STEP SIX

Flip the frame over to the back and attach the sawtooth hanger. Make sure to center the hanger in a place where both layers of wood overlap for greater strength and so the fasteners don't poke through.



STEP EIGHT

Finish your frame with paint, stain, or spray paint.
